

## Turn WHS Calculator into an App


On an iPhone, browse to the calculator using Safari, then with it displaying you will see the 'share' icon at the bottom of the screen that looks like a square with an arrow pointing out the top, as in this example:



Touch to select this icon, then scroll down till you see 'Add to Home Screen'. You are then given an opportunity to name the App, for example 'WHS Calculator' before hitting 'Add'. A shortcut icon then appears on the iPhone desktop just as if it were an App, as in the example below:



This process is very similar on Android phones: Launch Chrome, browse to the calculator, tap the **menu** icon (3 dots upper right) and tap 'Add to Home Screen'. Enter a name for the shortcut as above. This is illustrated in the screenshots below:



#### Notes:

Course Handicap (CH) = (Handicap Index) X (Slope Rating / 113) + (Course Rating – Par)

(when selecting a 9-hole format, Handicap Index is divided by 2)

Playing Handicap = CH X (Adjustment %) – then rounded to the nearest integer.

Rounded Course Handicap (RCH) = Integer Part of (CH + 0.5)

1. At startup Slope Ratings, Course Ratings and Par values are set to defaults, adjust these to match your course. Just edit the values in the boxes. Set values are retained for the next time you start the calculator.
2. For general, non-competition play use your Course Handicap. In competitions, Playing Handicap will determine the result, while your Course Handicap will determine the score used for updating your Handicap Index. Be mindful of your Course Handicap when deciding whether to pick up on a hole.
